When data is tracked, trended, and displayed it becomes a shared resource to drive change, confirm progress, and validate success.

Timely and actionable data is invaluable in highlighting both successes and areas for improvement. Data is easier to act on as a team when it is shared openly with providers, and patient outcomes tend to improve when data is shared among peers.



Create a provider data dashboard that displays patient panel outcomes for all providers to see. This helps identify top and lower performers for a particular outcome and displays trend changes over time. A provider dashboard may lead to a better understanding of what clinical behaviors tend to produce better patient outcomes.
